Warning! Imposters are asking SCE customers for immediate payment!

The Scam:

Scammers demand that customers buy prepaid debit cards. They then ask for the debit card number and collect money from the card.

Protect Yourself:

If you suspect a fraudulent call, ask for caller's name, department and phone number. If they refuse, hang up and report the call to SCE at 800-655-455 or Whittier Police at 562-567-9200.



A message for SCE customers:

- •SCE employees will never ask for money in person.
- •Never reveal your credit card, ATM, calling card, or PIN numbers to anyone who calls you.
- •If a caller asks you to leave your home at a specific time for a utility-related cause, call **Whittier Police Department** at 562-567-9200. This could be a burglary attempt.
- •Be suspicious of anyone who arrives without an appointment asking to check an appliance or wiring, or suggesting there is an electrical problem at your residence.
