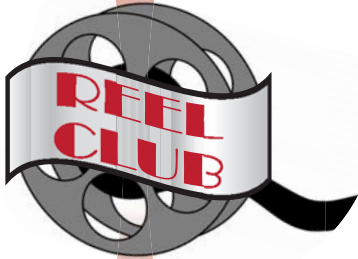


Movie fans! Join us for the finest in documentary films!
