Passport Day in Whittier



You are eligible to submit your application — without an appointment — on Whittier Central Library's Passport Day, Saturday, March 17, if one of the following applies to you:

You are a U.S. citizen applying to obtain one of the following:

- First-time passport **or**
- Replacement of a lost, stolen or damaged passport **or**
- Renewal of a passport that has been expired for more than 5 years **or**
- Renewal of passport issued to a minor age 15 or younger.

(Please note: We will **not** be accepting renewals by mail — the DS-82 forms — on *Passport Day*.)

How to Prepare

Pick up a copy of Whittier Public Library's **Passport Brochure** (available at Whittier Central & Whittwood Branch Libraries). It explains what you must bring to apply for a passport for yourself (or your child).

Saturday, March 17 • Passport Day in Whittier

Bring your completed passport application to **Central Library between 10 A.M. and 3:30 P.M.** to submit to a passport agent. (*Passport Day* is for walk-ins only, no appointments.)
