S.A.M. STRAPPING AND MARKING

Metro's S.T.A.R. Program (Safely Transporting All Riders) is committed to providing information on how people with disabilities can safely ride Metro's buses and trains. The S.T.A.R. Program offers free mobility device securement assistance through Strapping and Marking services.

Strapping and Marking (S.A.M.) is the process of finding the best place on a mobility device that can be used to safely secure the device when utilizing transportation. The area is then marked with yellow tape or a nylon tether to show the best placement of the securement hooks. The mobility device is examined by mobility specialists who are trained in finding the correct area based on how the device is built.
