Beginning August 25, your next EZ transit pass will be on TAP! The TAP card is a plastic card that will be loaded with an electronic EZ transit pass inside and an EZ transit pass stamp affixed outside.

There's no cost for the TAP card with purchase of an EZ transit pass.



Be sure to TAP on these systems:

- > Culver CityBus
- > Foothill
- > Gardena
- > LADOT
- > Metro
- > Montebello
- > Norwalk
- > Santa Clarita

Show your TAP card and stamp on all other non-TAP systems where EZ is accepted.

TAP it again and again.

Your TAP card can be used to load a pass, a one-way ride or stored value (cash) and it's good for up to three years.
