ORDINANCE NO. 3004

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING FEES FOR SOLID WASTE SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE CITY TO TAKE EFFECT FISCAL YEAR 2013-14

WHEREAS, Proposition 218 requires the City to conduct a public hearing not less than forty-five (45) days after mailing a notice of proposed property-related fee increases to record property owners of each identified parcel upon which the fees will be imposed;

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing regarding the proposed increases to fees for solid waste service was conducted on June 11, 2013, at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers;

WHEREAS, Proposition 218 requires that the City shall not impose the proposed fee if written protests against the proposed fee are presented by a majority of record owners of the identified parcels;

WHEREAS, written protests regarding the proposed solid waste collection fee increases were accepted from the public and considered before the close of the public hearing;

WHEREAS, a tally of the written protests against the proposed solid waste fee increases shows less than a majority of the record owners of the identified parcels have submitted written protests against the proposed solid waste fee increases;

WHEREAS, a final tally of the written protests submitted and copies of the written protests will be available for review in the City Clerk's Office; and

WHEREAS, the City Municipal Code, section 8.12.040 requires charges for the collection and removal of refuse be set by Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. <u>Rates</u>: That the rates/fees listed in Schedules A, B, C, D, E and F attached herewith shall be charged to residential and commercial accounts by the City for the purpose of collecting and disposing refuse and recycling material.

Single-family residential customers who apply and qualify for the utility users' tax exemption according to Whittier Municipal Code Section 3.24.110.A.2, shall be entitled to a discount on solid waste collection fees as listed in Schedule A.

Each parcel shall be charged for street sweeping services provided by the City as set forth in Schedule A. This service fee shall include a disposal cost for debris collected along public streets.

Residential developments having four or more units on a lot will be charged for the use of a City-provided container as set forth in Schedule B. Single-family residential customers and multiple-family dwelling accounts having less than four units total on a lot will not be charged for the initial container.

Roll-off container service may be obtained from the franchised hauler or the City, depending on the zone. Roll-off containers are available in sizes of 10, 20, 25, 30 and 40 cubic yards. Roll-off rental rates are listed in Schedules D and E. The rental rate for temporary roll-offs includes charges for container delivery, rental, collection, and disposal charges, and must be paid for in advance.

If a roll-off container is ordered by a resident or contractor from other than the City's Solid Waste Division or a franchised hauler, and is found placed within the City limits, it will be impounded and a fee, as set forth in Schedules D and E, will be charged for its release in addition to disposal costs.

The rental rate for containers in permanent service includes delivery, rental, collection, disposal charges, and return. These containers must be emptied and returned no less than once per month. As set forth in Schedule E, a charge applies for each request for cleaning of roll-off/compactors. These containers will be billed at the end of each month.

For residential customers (defined as any residential account consisting of less than four (4) units), special collection and disposal of bulky items is offered by the City's Solid Waste Division up to four (4) collections per year, for up to two items at each collection. For two (2) and three (3) unit properties, the request must be from the property owner or property manager, not the tenants. All properties four (4) units and above will also be entitled to four (4) free bulky item collections per year, two (2) items per collection at the request of the property owner or property manager. Such items include, but are not limited to, furniture and appliances (refrigerator doors with mechanical latches must be removed). Such service shall be available free of charge, provided that collection is requested in advance and scheduled on a regular collection day. For residential and commercial accounts, rates for special services and special collection and disposal of large or unusual jobs are based on the time and material(s) involved. Designated Solid Waste personnel shall determine the appropriate charge.

SECTION 2. That all Resolutions and Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions hereof, including, but not limited to Ordinance 2988 are hereby repealed and rescinded.

SECTION 3. Resident Disposal Permit: Any occupant of a single-family residence in the City may obtain a permit for six (6) entries into Savage Canyon Landfill for the exclusive purpose of disposing household garbage, trash and rubbish. Each entry shall be transported on a vehicle no larger than a 3/4-ton pick-up truck or equivalent trailer. Such permit may be obtained from the City's Public Works

Department for a fee as set forth in Schedule F. Only one permit will be issued to a single-family residence per year. The use of the permit shall be restricted to the disposal of refuse generated at the qualifying address as shown on the permit. The permit shall not be used by any holder thereof for the purpose of disposing refuse that is generated at a location or locations other than that of the qualifying address or in connection with any commercial establishment or enterprise such as gardening, landscaping, construction or trash collection. Any person using such permit shall be required to show additional proof of residency, such as a valid driver's license, upon entrance at Savage Canyon Landfill's gatehouse.

SECTION 4. Resident Special Saturday Discount: Any occupant of a single-family residence in the City may dispose of one load (transported on a vehicle no larger than a 3/4 ton pick-up truck or equivalent trailer) of household refuse per Saturday. Such discount may be obtained from Savage Canyon Landfill for an amount set forth in Schedule F with the limitation of one (1) load per Saturday. The use of the discount shall be restricted to the disposal of refuse generated at the qualifying address. The discount shall not be used by any holder thereof for the purpose of disposing refuse which is generated at a location or locations other than that of the qualifying address or in connection with any commercial establishment or enterprise such as gardening, landscaping, construction or trash collection, nor shall the discount be used to dispose refuse acquired from two or more apartment units. Any person requesting such discount shall be required to show proof of residency, such as a valid driver's license, upon entrance at Savage Canyon Landfill's gatehouse.

SECTION 5. All solid waste collection and disposal rate changes shall take effect beginning August 1, 2013.

SECTION 6. Any provision of the Whittier Municipal Code or appendices thereto inconsistent with the provisions of the Ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistencies and no further, are repealed or modified to that extent necessary to affect the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council of the City of Whittier hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 8. The Mayor shall sign and the City Clerk shall attest to the passage of this Ordinance. The City Clerk shall cause the same to be published once in the official newspaper within 15 days after its adoption. This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days from its adoption.
