

RESOLUTION NO. 8524

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING PREFERENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT NO. 1 AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS APPLICABLE THERETO

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Whittier adopted Chapter 10.18 of the Whittier Municipal Code establishing a Preferential Parking Program as authorized by California Vehicle Code Section 22507;

WHEREAS, Chapter 10.18 authorizes the City Council to designate, by resolution, those areas in the City that shall be subject to preferential parking by permit;

WHEREAS, the City Council has heretofore determined that the area of Rose Drive from Greenleaf Avenue to Milton Avenue suffers from a severe shortage of on-street parking, as well as the other problems associated with the proximity of Hellman Wilderness Park. Based thereon, it is the intent of the City Council in adopting this Resolution to minimize said problems and provide for more on-street parking by designating said area as a preferential parking district; and.

WHEREAS, all legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are a substantial part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. Rose Drive from Greenleaf Avenue to Milton Avenue including all adjacent residences is hereby designated "Preferential Parking District No. 1."

SECTION 3. It is unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on Rose Drive within the Preferential Parking District No.1 unless such person has been issued a currently valid preferential parking permit for said district pursuant to Chapter 10.18 of the Whittier Municipal Code, and displays said permit at all times within his or her parked vehicle by hanging the same from the interior rear-view mirror, or as otherwise directed by the director of public works.

SECTION 4. Use of a preferential parking permit is subject to all terms and conditions set forth in Chapter 10.18 of the Whittier Municipal Code.

SECTION 5. Permit types. The following are types of permit available:

(a) Annual residential permit. This permit is valid for the calendar year renewable on December 31, may be renewed, and is only available to residents within the

District. Annual residential permits are subject to the prohibition in WMC 10.18.080(c).

- (b) Guest permit. The City Manager may issue guest permits on an annual or temporary basis for use by residents and their guests. Guest permits are not subject to the prohibition in WMC 10.18.080(c) and may be shared among permit holders and their guests.

SECTION 6. Number of Permits. The number of annual residential permits issued per single-family residence shall not exceed one permit for each vehicle with a valid registration issued by the California Department of Motor Vehicles and showing the address of the permit applicant. Temporary guest permits may be issued without limitation on an as-needed basis to residents within the District and shall be valid for one calendar day. No more than three annual guest permits may be issued per residence in the District.

SECTION 7. Permit Filing Fee. There shall be no filing fee for permits in Parking District No. 1, except that replacement annual residential permits and replacement annual guest permits shall each be subject to a \$50 replacement fee.

SECTION 8. The provisions of this Resolution shall not become effective unless and until the City has installed signs sufficient to provide notice to persons within Preferential Parking District No. 1 of the parking restrictions set forth in Section 3 of this Resolution.

SECTION 9. The City Clerk-Treasurer shall certify to the passage and adoption hereof.
