Kyle Cason began as Interim Director of Public Works on August 12, 2019 when Dave Schickling retired. Kyle manages the City's streets, water, sewer, solid waste, and fleet functions. Kyle will lead the Public Works Department with integrity, ethics, and respect while providing the City's residents with exceptional service.

Kyle has worked for the City of Whittier since 2010, when he was hired as a Civil Engineering Assistant. He received a promotion to Civil Engineering Associate, followed by a promotion to Senior Civil Engineer in 2015 and a promotion to Assistant Director of Public Works in 2017. Prior to joining the City, Kyle worked for a private civil engineering firm in Santa Ana, CA. Kyle continues to coordinate the engineering plans, utility plans, and daily construction activities for "*The Groves*" project on the former Fred C. Nelles Youth Correctional Facility site, as well as managing the Greenway Trail East Extension project.

Kyle holds a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from Valparaiso University in Indiana, where he grew up. Kyle is a registered civil engineer and holds a water operator license in distribution (grade D2) along with being an active member of both the American Water Works Association and the American Society of Civil Engineers.
