Good evening Mayor and Members of the City Council,

My name is Crystal Ramos and I am a resident of the Cambridge Place Homeowners Association off Magnolia and Hadley in Whittier, CA.

I am here tonight to formally and urgently request action regarding the intersection near Magnolia and Hadley. This intersection has been the site of repeated traffic incidents over time, and residents in the surrounding neighborhood have consistently raised concerns about its safety.

This is not a new issue. There is a clear pattern of collisions occurring at this location. These incidents have already had serious consequences for members of our community. One accident resulted in a neighbor sustaining injuries severe enough to leave them physically incapacitated, with lasting impacts on their life. In another incident, a vehicle struck our HOA property, causing direct structural damage to the exterior of our building. Those repairs were paid for by the homeowners association, meaning residents absorbed the financial cost.

Beyond these specific incidents, neighbors continue to report ongoing concerns about traffic behavior, visibility issues, and the overall safety of the intersection. Taken together, this reflects a consistent and unresolved safety risk that continues to affect our community.

Given the repeated nature and severity of these incidents, this is no longer a matter for informal review. It requires formal evaluation and action. The intersection should be assessed for safety improvements, including potential traffic calming measures, signage changes, lighting adjustments, enforcement, or redesign options.

We are formally requesting that the Magnolia and Hadley intersection be placed on the agenda for the next available City Council meeting and that the City move forward with a real plan to address the ongoing safety issues at this intersection.
